August 14: Final decision-making

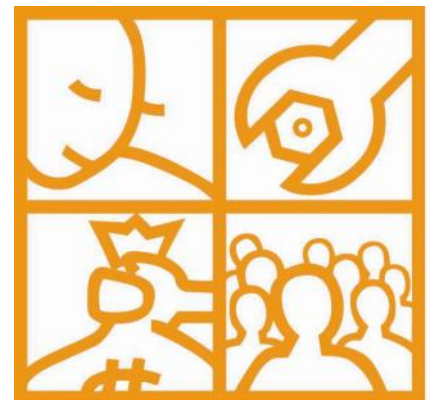
