



Momentum Giving Project (Alumni only)

Momentum Projects are designed to quickly fund organizations working on “Movement Moments” - issues that are at a critical mass in terms of public awareness, organizing momentum, and potential for impact. Previous project topics have included Police Accountability, Housing Justice, and Black-led Organizing.

With less time commitment (four to five meetings over two to three months) but high impact, this model is the one inch punch of social justice philanthropy - a way for Giving Project alumni to stay engaged and challenged in their donor organizing, while learning more about a focused aspect of our grantmaking.
